



DRAMA WORKSHOP - CODE OF CONDUCT

General rules

1. You must not behave in a way that upsets other people, for example by shouting or swearing.
2. No bullying, aggression or being unkind to others will be tolerated.
3. All members should listen to and respect other people's opinions and be friendly
4. All members must agree to abide by this Code of Conduct. If you repeatedly break these rules you may be given a verbal or written warning, and you could be suspended or even excluded from Croydon Contacts

In addition, at Drama Workshop:

5. You should pay your fee for Drama Workshop on the day you attend. Charges are per session. If you have problems, please speak to the Drama Tutor
6. No music players or phones should be used during class
7. Photos and/or Video recordings may be made of activities which you appear in. These will only be shared with other Croydon Contacts Members and/or at Drama Shows but please let the Drama Tutor know if you have any concerns or queries about this
8. Be punctual and phone the Croydon Contacts phone if you can't attend or will be late
9. You must follow any requests or instructions from the Drama Tutor and Assistant
10. Please let them know if you are going to the toilet or need to leave class
11. Please let them know if you need any support or assistance for example to leave at the lunch break to buy food at local shops
