



CINEMA CLUB GUIDELINES

When can I book for Sunday Cinema?

- Please check your Programme for forthcoming Cinema dates (we will also remind you by text and/or email that Cinema Club is coming soon).

When will I be told the details?

- You can tell us sometime ahead that you want to come but we cannot confirm details till a few days before the Club date. We can then tell you what film we are seeing, what time to arrive at the Cinema, and when it will finish

Why can't I book earlier?

- Because the cinema does not publish the films or screen times before the Tuesday or Wednesday before the Club date, and we then have to decide which film to see and at what time

How do you choose which film to see?

- We select a film that we think most members will enjoy. We normally select a film around midday /lunchtime, as that avoids an early start but also allows people to go home for lunch or onto another activity later in the day.

Do I have to book – can I just turn up?

- If you have not booked please do not just turn up.
- This is because we have to tell the cinema in advance how many are coming, and we need to know numbers to make sure we have enough trustees/ volunteers to support people.

What is the current cinema ticket price?

- Grants Vue cinema currently charges £7.99 for all films
- This may change in future. We will let you know when you book if it has changed

Do Carers have to pay?

- Each Member can be accompanied by one Carer who can have a free ticket.

In the Cinema

- Please make sure we know when you arrive! We will go as a group to buy tickets. After getting your ticket, please wait for a Trustee / volunteer to accompany you to the Screen where the film will be showing
- Please ONLY sit in the numbered seat shown on your ticket. If you sit in another seat, you may have to move when other people arrive, which can be annoying and disruptive especially if the film has started
- Please tell someone if you need to go to the toilet
- At the end – please wait for us to count everyone – we need to make sure we know everyone is present before people leave – Don't just walk off at the end without telling someone!
